

Guidelines for In-Person Events by the Global Student Forum

The following guidelines are designed to ensure a safe, enjoyable, and inclusive experience for all participants during in-person events organized by the Global Student Forum.

Registration and Attendance

- Register for the event in advance, providing accurate and complete information.
- Check in upon arrival and wear your event identification (e.g., badge, wristband) at all times.
- Attend only the sessions and activities for which you are registered or invited.

Health and Safety

- Follow any public health guidelines and event-specific measures related to COVID-19 or other health concerns (e.g., wearing masks, social distancing, hand hygiene).
- Refrain from attending the event if you are feeling unwell or have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Notify event organizers of any health and safety concerns or incidents.

Conduct and Behavior

- Treat all participants with respect, dignity, and fairness, in accordance with the Global Student Forum Code of Conduct.
- Avoid engaging in any form of harassment, discrimination, or misconduct.
- Respect the privacy and personal boundaries of others.
- Obtain consent before taking photos or videos of other participants.

Venue and Facilities

- Follow all venue-specific rules and guidelines.
- Keep the event space clean and dispose of waste appropriately.
- Be mindful of noise levels and avoid causing disruptions.
- Respect designated quiet zones and accessibility accommodations.

Alcohol and Substance Use

- Consume alcohol responsibly, if permitted, and only in designated areas.
- Do not provide alcohol to underage participants.
- Refrain from using illegal substances during the event.

Reporting Misconduct

- Report any violations of the Global Student Forum Code of Conduct to the Trusted Person Team.
- Cooperate with event organizers and staff during any investigations or interventions related to misconduct.

Consequences for Non-Compliance

- Be aware that violations of these guidelines may result in sanctions, such as a warning, removal from the event, or a ban from future events.
