

Regulatory Document on the Use of AI for Text and Illustrations

The Global Student Forum is committed to responsible and ethical use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in its operations. This regulatory document outlines the guidelines for the use of AI technologies for generating text and illustrations, ensuring transparency, fairness, and respect for human rights and intellectual property.

This regulation applies to all staff, volunteers, and third-party partners of the Global Student Forum using AI tools in their work related to content creation, publications, and communication.

Guidelines for AI-Generated Text

- AI-generated text must be fact-checked by human editors before being published or distributed.
- AI tools should not be used to produce content that plagiarizes or violates copyright.
- AI tools can inadvertently reflect societal biases. All text generated using AI must be reviewed for bias or harmful language and corrected accordingly.
- Human oversight is required to refine and contextualize AI-generated text, ensuring it aligns with GSF's goals, tone, and style.

Guidelines for AI-Generated Illustrations

- AI-generated illustrations must reflect GSF's commitment to diversity. Tools should be programmed to avoid racial, gender, or cultural bias in visual representations.
- Any use of AI to generate illustrations must be disclosed in relevant captions, credits, or documentation.
- Final approval of AI-generated images must involve human designers or editors to ensure the content meets aesthetic and ethical standards.

Prohibited Uses

- AI cannot be used to create content that could mislead or misinform audiences.
- The creation of deceptive or manipulative content, including deepfakes, is strictly prohibited.

- AI should not be used to replicate styles or works of specific artists or creators without proper authorization.

Enforcement

Violations of this policy follow the guidelines outlined in the GSF Code of Conduct.
